I just heard a great client story you may have interest in. They have tried numerous things to get rid of very stubborn pigeons in and around a canopy.

Their maintenance person received one of our owls and went out to spook the birds. He felt very silly carrying the owl around, so he hid it behind his back until he got very close to the birds. At that point, he took it out from behind his back and moved his arm with the owl in his hand and reported that the pigeons may have tried to kill him.

The birds reacted so violently trying to get away from the moving owl that they tried escaping through an opening only large enough for 1 pigeon at a time and two of them got stuck in there! Ever since they posted the owl in one portion of the facility, there haven't been birds near it for several days in succession.
