We recently received and installed a roll of Irrig-Tape to deter geese from our lake property. It has truly done the job and we are spreading the news to our neighbors. We have been so happy not to have their "droppings" in the yard and maybe we can retire our "pooper scooper".

The only problem or question we have is why the Holographic is no longer on (stretches of length) five to six feet of the tape. Areas are now just clear or see-through. Is this common? We installed ours about 20 inches above ground attached to plant supports which "give" somewhat in a breeze. We twisted it as instructions stated.

 (12" to 20" above ground)  
As I said before, we are delighted with the results and hope to use it again in future. Just curious as to why it fades off and if we're able to do something to prevent it. We installed it in mid July '06. Also question if still effective when Holographics are gone.
