
Dear Aaron,

Last year I purchased a summer home on Barnegat Bay at the New Jersey shore. In an attempt to ward off seagulls, the original owner had installed a series of steel wires along the copper roof ridge and at the chimneys. The system was charged with low voltage electricity supplied by a solar panel and designed to shock a bird that landed and touched it. Unfortunately, the high salt environment of the shore had rusted the system beyond repair, and the house, property and docks were overrun with seagulls and splattered with their droppings. In addition, ducks were landing in the pool and on the patio.

I called Bird-X, who recommended installing a BirdXPeller PRO on the roof, two Terror Eyes at the bulkhead and a Prowler Owl on the docks. I purchased these items, along with Irri-Tape for areas that small birds were nesting in and two Gator Guards for the pool.

Since that time, the seagull, small bird and duck problem on my property has been virtually eliminated, saving me hours of cleanup each weekend. I have recommended the products to all of my friends who have waterfront or shore homes, and would do the same for any person who has a bird problem similar to mine.
